

## **PRESOLICITATION NOTICE: Mobile Telephone services.**

### **PURPOSE**

This is a U.S. Embassy Athens Pre-Solicitation Notice only. Vendors are requested to read the below requirements. No responses are requested by this notice. The U.S. Embassy Athens issues this notice with the intent of giving an opportunity to all interested parties to appropriately prepare for the anticipated Request for Quotations (RFQ).

**This is not a request for quotation; this is for pre-solicitation / informational purposes only. No award will be made on the basis of responses received to this notice.**

### **BACKGROUND**

The U.S. Embassy Athens has a requirement for mobile telephone services.

### **PROPOSED CONTRACT ACTION**

The Vendor shall provide services as described herein to meet the mission requirements of the U.S. Embassy Athens.

Accordingly, the U.S. Embassy Athens plans the issuance of the following solicitation (RFQ):

1. RFQ Title: **Mobile Telephone Services.**
2. RFQ issuance date: Early-September 2020.
3. RFQ issuance method: The solicitation will be posted on the website of the U.S. Embassy Athens, Greece at <https://gr.usembassy.gov/> under the “*Business Opportunities*” section. The awardee will be required to speak, write and correspond in English language.
4. RFQ response date: in early-October 2020.
5. Award date: To be determined.
6. Award procedures: In accordance with FAR 15.3 Source Selection.
7. Duration of performance period: One year.
8. Place of performance: Athens, Greece.
9. Special contract requirements:

The Contractor shall possess all permits, licenses, and any other appointments required for the prosecution of work under this contract.

**SAM Registration is required pursuant to FAR provision 5.207, and prospective offerors are encouraged to register prior to the submittal of proposals.**
